small group instruction with low 5 to 1 student to coach ratio, tailored to each skaters' age and ability. As well as large group instruction utilizing the entire ice surface. Skaters will learn the basics to powerful skating and begin to learn the proper jumping and spinning techniques as well as form and posture.
